

**Parking**

For the convenience of patients and families, UPMC Mercy offers an indoor parking garage across the street from the hospital. Entrances are located on Stevenson Street and Forbes Avenue. From the garage, take the elevators to Level D (the yellow level). Exit the elevators and enter the hospital through the foot bridge/walkway.

Additional indoor parking is also available below the M.D. Building; the entrance to this garage is located on Pride Street between Locust Street and Forbes Avenue.

Outdoor parking is available on Locust Street at Marion Street and on Forbes Avenue at Pride Street. In addition, limited metered parking is available on Stevenson Street and in the 1400 and 1500 blocks of Forbes Avenue.

Valet parking is available for patients and visitors upon request at the main entrances to UPMC Mercy (Buildings D and E) from 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. weekdays and at regular parking rates. Please see the parking attendants on duty. Valet parking is also available on weekends at the main entrance to Building E.

Handicapped parking is available in all parking areas.

For patients of the UPMC Mercy Emergency Department, limited free parking is available in the lot directly outside the entrance to the Emergency Department. To ensure that your car is not ticketed or towed, please alert security personnel in the Emergency Department waiting room.

Special parking rates are available for immediate family members of patients admitted to the hospital for a long stay. Please contact the Security Office at 412-232-7998 for more information.

**Public and Private Transportation**

Public transportation from Downtown Pittsburgh to UPMC Mercy is currently available via the Port Authority of Allegheny County 61, 71, 500 and 84C bus routes. Bus stops are located within a one- to two-block radius of the hospital. # Driving DIRECTIONS

## North

### From I-80:

Follow I-80 to I-79 South, Exit 19A. From I-79, proceed to Exit 72, Pittsburgh/I-279 South. Follow I-279 South approximately 15 miles to Exit 8A, I-579 South/Veteran's Bridge. Take the 6th Avenue/7th Avenue exit. Take the ramp toward Mellon Boulevard. Proceed to the traffic light and turn right onto Washington Place. Washington Place becomes Chatham Square. Proceed through the next two intersections. At the second intersection, turn left onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed through three traffic lights and turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.

### From I-79 South & I-279 South:

Proceed to Exit 72, Pittsburgh/I-279 South. Follow I-279 South approximately 15 miles to Exit 8A, I-579 South/Veteran's Bridge. Take the 6th Avenue/7th Avenue Exit. Follow the signs toward Mellon Arena. Turn left onto Bigelow Boulevard. Proceed to the traffic light and turn right onto Washington Place. Washington Place becomes Chatham Square. Proceed through the next two intersections. At the second intersection, turn left onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed through three lights and turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.

### From Rt. 28 South:

Start out going south on PA-28 South/Blue Belt/Allegheny Valley Expressway. Continue to follow PA-28 South for 3.1 miles. Merge onto I-579 South toward the Liberty Bridge. Take the 6th Avenue /7th Avenue Exit. Take the ramp toward Mellon Arena. Turn left onto Bigelow Boulevard. Turn right onto Washington Place. Washington Place becomes Chatham Square. Turn left onto Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Stevenson Street. Turn left onto Locust Street. UPMC Mercy is on the right.

### From Rt. 65 South:

Start out going south on Ohio River Boulevard/PA-65 South. Continue to follow PA-65 South. Merge onto I-279 South toward I-376 East/Downtown Pittsburgh/Fort Pitt Bridge/Airport/Monroeville. Take Exit 6A on the left toward I-376 East/Downtown/Monroeville. Stay straight to go onto Fort Pitt Boulevard. Make a slight left to take the Smithfield Street ramp toward Grant Street. Make a slight left-hand turn onto Grant Street. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed through three traffic lights. Turn right onto Stevenson Street. Turn left onto Locust Street. UPMC Mercy is on the right.

## South

### From I-70 North:

Follow I-70 North to I-79 North. Proceed on I-79 North to Exit 59A, Pittsburgh/I-279

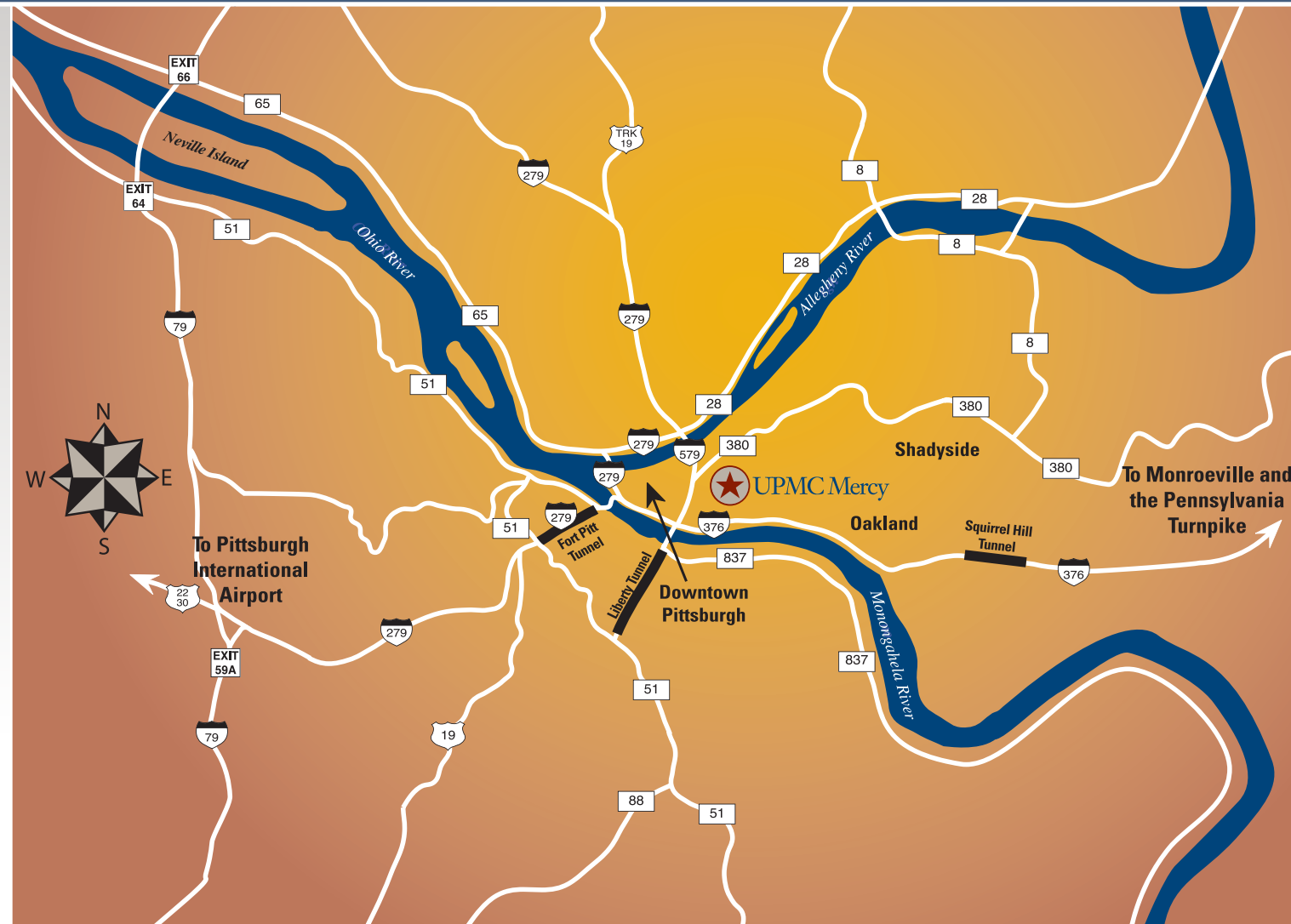
North. Follow I-279 North approximately seven miles through the Fort Pitt Tunnel, staying in the right lane as you approach the tunnel. Use the right exit for Monroeville/I-376 East at the end of the Fort Pitt Bridge. Proceed approximately two-tenths of a mile and exit left at Grant Street/Exit 1C. Proceed on Grant Street to the fifth traffic light at Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed approximately one-half mile to Pride Street. Turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.

### From I-79 North:

Use Exit 59A, Pittsburgh/I-279 North. Follow I-279 North approximately seven miles through the Fort Pitt Tunnel, staying in the right lane as you approach the tunnel. Use the right exit for Monroeville/I-376 East at the end of the Fort Pitt Bridge. Proceed approximately two-tenths of a mile and exit left at Grant Street/Exit 1C. Proceed on Grant to the fifth traffic light at Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed approximately one-half mile to Pride Street. Make a right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.

### From Route 51 North:

Follow Route 51 North to the Liberty Tunnel; turn right into the tunnel. Proceed through the tunnel and across Liberty Bridge; use Forbes Avenue/Downtown Exit. At the traffic light, turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed through three more traffic lights and turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.



## East

### From I-76 Pennsylvania Turnpike (Westbound)/I-376:

Follow I-76 West to Exit 57, Pittsburgh/Monroeville I-376. Proceed on I-376 West approximately 12 miles to Exit 2B, Boulevard of the Allies. Stay in the right lane and continue on the Boulevard of the Allies for approximately one mile. At the intersection of Marion Street and Boulevard of the Allies, turn right onto Marion Street. Travel one block and turn left onto Locust Street. UPMC Mercy is on the left.

## West

### West From Rt. 60/U.S. Rt. 22/30 East and Pittsburgh International Airport:

U.S. 22/30 East merges with I-279 North at the intersection with I-79. Follow I-279 North approximately seven miles through the Fort Pitt Tunnel, staying in the right lane as you approach the tunnel. Use the right exit for Monroeville/I-376 East at the end of the Fort Pitt Bridge. Proceed approximately two-tenths of a mile and exit left at Grant Street/Exit 1C. Proceed on Grant Street to the fifth traffic light at Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed approximately one-half mile to Pride Street. Turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.

### From I-76 Pennsylvania Turnpike (Eastbound):

Use Exit 28 Cranberry/I-79 South. Follow I-79 South to Exit 72, Pittsburgh/I-279 South. Follow I-279 South approximately 15 miles to Exit 8A, I-579 South/Veteran's Bridge. Look for and follow all signs indicating Mellon Arena. Proceed to the traffic light and turn right onto Washington Place. Proceed through the next two intersections. At the second intersection, turn left onto Forbes Avenue. Proceed on Forbes Avenue for approximately one-half mile. Turn right onto Pride Street. UPMC Mercy is straight ahead.
