Nestled in the heart of Penn Hills, the scenic campus setting at Seneca Place, part of UPMC Senior Communities, warmly greets patients and families. Neatly landscaped yards and colorful pathways lead into this spacious and brightly lit skilled nursing and rehabilitation facility.

Seneca Place provides a variety of programs that meet the needs of patients who no longer require hospital care, but need 24-hour skilled nursing and rehabilitation services. A team of UPMC professionals work to enhance quality of life and return patients to their highest level of independent functioning. Caring, dedicated staff provide comprehensive skilled nursing and rehabilitation services that address the physical, psychological, and social needs of each patient.

Partnering with the UPMC Rehabilitation Institute, Seneca Place offers a Transitional Rehabilitation Unit (TRU) that provides exceptional care for short-stay skilled patients. The Seneca campus also includes Seneca Manor, assisted living, and Seneca Hills Village, independent living residences.

Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Services

For patients requiring 24-hour skilled nursing care, Seneca Place also offers the following specialized services on site:

- IV therapy
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Private and semi-private rooms
- Total parental nutrition (TPN)
- Wound care services
- Transitional Rehabilitation Unit (TRU) for short-stay skilled patients
- Hospice care
- Respite care
- Feeding tubes
- Respiratory care
- Pulse lavage-cleansing, trauma and other soft tissue wounds
- Pastoral care
- 24-hour visitation
- Telemedicine
- Palliative care nurse practitioner on-site

In collaboration with the UPMC Rehabilitation Institute and UPMC Centers for Rehab Services, Seneca Place offers a strong patient-focused rehabilitation program. As a result, Seneca Place residents reap the combined benefits of outstanding physical, occupational, speech, and restorative therapies as physicians work to develop new treatments that are shared across UPMC.




Transitional Rehabilitation Unit

The Transitional Rehab Unit (TRU) at Seneca Place is a short-stay rehabilitation unit designed to meet the needs of patients being discharged from the hospital. With oversight by the UPMC Rehabilitation Institute, the TRU is able to discharge skilled patients after successfully managing their rehabilitation needs.

Goals:

- Promote a safe and timely transition for short-term rehab patients
- Provide individual patient focused rehabilitation services
- Promote quality care and provide continuity of treatment plans
- Appropriately utilize benefits

Managed by the UPMC Rehabilitation Institute, the TRU at Seneca Place offers this specialized rehabilitation unit to meet the needs of patients requiring additional rehabilitation. As a result, patients admitted to the TRU achieve the highest level of independence possible before discharge.




Facility Features

- Skilled care provided by licensed health care
- Telemedicine enabling Geriatricians to complete remote patient assessments
- Respite care offering short-term care for families needing personal time
- Registered nurse supervisors 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Continued care by patients' personal physicians credentialed by Seneca Place, or the option to select from the Seneca Place physicians
- Hospice services for families coping with terminally ill patients
- Comprehensive wound care provided by a Certified Wound Nurse
- Cancer treatment support for patients with all types of cancer
- Daily monitoring of patient nutritional needs and therapeutic diets by a registered, licensed dietitian
- Discharge planning offering continuity of care

Facility Amenities

- Three delicious meals daily
- Secure environment equipped with on-site surveillance, coded doors, and an emergency evacuation plan
- Family council, patient council, and caregiver support groups on a regular basis
- 24-hour visitation
- Coordinated exercise programs, games, arts and crafts, sports, music, and other entertainment for patients
- Scheduled visitation times for family pets
- Outdoor courtyard
- On-site pastoral counseling and interdenominational church services
- On-site gift shop
- In-house salon and barber shop, and complete housekeeping and laundry services
